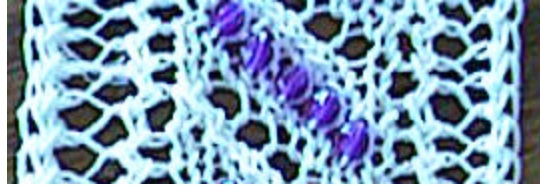


Beaded Candy Stripe Insertion

worked on 15 sts



String 5 beads on your thread for each band, in reverse order from that in which they will be knitted. If you're going to graft the ends of the strip together, start by stringing 3 beads of the color that will bridge the seam, and end with 2 beads of the same color.

Right-hand columns show the row numbers and direction of knitting.

Key to symbols:

O = yo

B = place bead by sliding into place and knitting, throwing thread the "wrong" way around needle, so that it will twist when purled. On the following purl row, make sure the stitch with the bead is twisted.

On front side rows (odd numbers)

| = knit

^ = ssk (slip, slip knit -- or slip 1, k1, pss0)

\ = ssk

On back side rows (even numbers)

| = purl

^ = p 2 tog

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
